5 Steps to a Grade-A Essay (Without the Stress)

Writing doesn't have to be a mystery. At CoreMastery Academy, we believe every student can produce high-quality academic writing by following a repeatable system. This blueprint is that system.

Step 1: The Thesis "Anchor"

Before you write a single word, you must define your argument.

The Formula: [Subject] + [Action Verb] + [Three Specific Reasons].

Example: "The fur trade transformed Canadian society by altering local economies, creating new social classes, and shifting political alliances."

Step 2: The "Reverse" Outline

Don't write chronologically. Map your three reasons from Step 1 into three distinct Body Paragraphs.

Paragraph 1: Economic Alterations.

Paragraph 2: Social Classes.

Paragraph 3: Political Alliances.

Step 3: The PEEL Paragraph Method

Every paragraph must follow this structure to ensure clarity:

P (Point): State the main idea of the paragraph.

E (Evidence): Provide a quote or a fact.

E (Explanation): Explain how the evidence proves your point.

L (Link): Connect this idea back to your main Thesis.

Step 4: The Vocabulary "Power-Up"

Replace "weak" words with "academic" words to instantly boost your grade.

Instead of "shows", use: Illustrates, Demonstrates, Exemplifies.

Instead of "bad", use: Detrimental, Adverse, Suboptimal.

Instead of "think", use: Postulate, Argue, Assert.

Step 5: The "Read Aloud" Polish

The secret to an 'A' is flow. Read your essay out loud. If you trip over a sentence, your teacher will too. Shorten long sentences and vary your word choice.
